#### **Reminders:**

- Fees If you pay for your child to attend please make sure you do this on time!
- Bring a healthy lunchbox (no nuts or sweets please), water bottle, labelled bag with nappies & wipes (if applicable), a spare set of clothes (even if your child is toilet trained they may have an accident or just get wet during water play!), a jumper & coat
- Weather please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather including footwear and that they have coats etc with them when needed
- <u>Label everything! We are not able to remember what things belong to what child and your child may not always be able to tell us themselves. In particular ensure bags, lunchboxes and water bottles are labelled.</u>
- Inform please let us know if your child is going to be absent and why, if they have had an accident at home, if you've moved or changed your phone number or if someone we haven't seen before is collecting your child.
- Phones please do NOT use your mobile phone while you are within Busy Lizzie's this is necessary to ensure the safety of the children in our care.
- Clothing children will get messy so please do not send them in their best clothes!
